A research scholar at Columbia University, Dr. Les Joynes examines the future of art education. With thirty-five years of international experience, Les was 2022 Fulbright Senior Fellow at the Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts and Visiting Associate Professor at Visva Bharati University in India. He has also served as Professor of Record for Modern and

Contemporary Art History and Practice at Renmin University, Beijing and has lectured on contemporary art at Cambridge University, Peking University, National Taiwan Normal University and the Royal Academy Schools. He has been active with CAA for twenty years and has served on CAA's International Committee and Museum Committee. He initiated CAA's Artistic Research Group in 2018 to explore new research models in art education.

Also a visual artist, Joynes has exhibited his work globally, including at the Art Gallery of New South Wales, Brazilian Museum of Sculpture, Museum of Brazilian Art, Norimatsu Museum, Beijing Inside Out Museum, and Barbican and Milch Gallery in London. He is represented by Thomas Jaeckel Gallery in New York.
